СЕМИНАР ПО ЗАРУБЕЖНОЙ ЛИТЕРАТУРЕ В 10 КЛАССЕ

В период подготовки учащиеся поделены на группы. Каждая группа готовит сообщение о жизни и творчестве одного из писателей.

Ход семинара

I. Вводная часть:

Teacher. Good morning, dear friends! Today we'll have a seminar. We'll speak about English and American writers. First of all answer my questions, please.

- What English and American writers do you know?
- Do you think it is important to know foreign literature?
- Why do you think it is important?
- I agree with you. I think it is very important to study foreign literature, because we should know not only the language but also the traditions and customs and the literature of other nationalities.

Today we'll speak about some English and American writers. They are:

- 1. Mark Twain (1835-1900)
- 2. Agatha Christie (1890-1976)
- 3. Rudyard Kipling (1865-1936)
- 4. William Shakespeare (1564-1616)

(Оборудование – портреты этих и других писателей на доске).

First of all we'll listen to your talk about them, then we'll do a short test which, I have prepared for you and at last we'll do a crossword.

II. Творческий отчет учащихся о М.Твене.

- Let's listen about Mark Twain. (1 Группа ребят рассказывает о жизни писателя, делает творческий отчет по сбору информации о Марке Твене).

Teacher: - Now, I'd like you to listen to one of M.Twain's stories. The title of this story is "The King and the Painter." (Прослушивание текста в записи).

- You have listened to the funny story. And now answer my questions:
- 1. What are the main characters of this story?
- 2. Why did everybody say that they liked his picture?
- 3. Who disliked his pictures one day?
- 4. What did the King do with the painter?
- 5. When did he ask him again about his pictures?
- 6. What did the painter answer?

Now let's listen about Agatha Christie. (2 группа ребят делает отчет о жизни и творчестве Агаты Кристи).

Teacher:

- Now, what books written by Agatha Christie have you read?
- What is your favorite character in her books?
- Why do you like such books?

The next writer we'll hear about is Rudyard Kipling. (Учащиеся рассказывают о писателе и его творчестве. Читают стихи Киплинга на английском и русском языках).

V. Творческий отчет учащихся о В. Шекспире.

Teacher. And now I'd like to draw your attention to one of the most important writers. We may call him the father of English literature, William Shakespeare

(Учащиеся рассказывают о творчестве писателя. Можно представить короткие постановки из пьес Шекспира).

Teacher. Thank you for your information and now I'd like you to do a short test.


